



**IF THE FOUNDATIONS BE DESTROYED,
WHAT CAN THE RIGHTEOUS DO?**

Psalm 11

Welcome to Concord on this wonderful Sunday before our annual celebration of Independence Day. It is good to be here this morning and we welcome you to a good day of worship.

This morning we are going to ask the question that makes up Psalm 11:3. What can we do if the foundations of all we hold dear in a society are destroyed? The short answer is that we will look to the Lord when foundations are destroyed. That is what the righteous do.

William Booth was the founder of the Salvation Army. He died in 1912. His ministry lives on. Before his death he spoke of the danger the next century would bring to the church. He saw six things on the horizon.

We seem to be experiencing the things he saw. America is suffering the loss of a national ethic because the Church has lost its voice. An "ethic" is a set of moral principles or a system of moral values. This set of values is exactly what is encountered when the church takes its proper role in society.

This morning we are looking at four of the foundation stones that must not be destroyed.
